

## “What is the most pressing sociological issue facing health care recipients today?”

The most pressing issue facing health care recipients, especially disabled Americans, is that many are subjugated by the pharmaceutical companies, the medical community, and the government, who are involved in getting millions of Americans hooked on some type of drug or another, which provides a continual revenue stream for numerous agencies and corporations.

The devastation is extreme, as millions of peoples' minds and bodies are warped by these drugs, many of which cause irreparable damage. The current situation plays a major role in driving up our health care costs, as prescription drug prices are artificially inflated, and as insurance companies pay out huge settlements to cover damage caused by the out-of-control pharmaceutical industry.

How can this type of slaughter be prevented? Here are some guidelines that I have developed for identifying harmful situations that may help people avoid getting caught up in modern-day sorcery (the guidelines are an excerpt from another document):

2. Some manufacturing, use, and selling of drugs,<sup>3</sup> legal and otherwise, especially when used in conjunction with the subjugation of others or for monetary profit, specifically that driven by greed or the love of money. This should not preclude the right of the individual in choosing for himself, without requiring the permission of a doctor, the government or even other people, what substances, or foods, for better or worse, life or death, sustenance or countenance, one chooses to ingest, or eat.
3. Tarot cards (and some other decks, or stacks of chips) and their reading and interpretation as it relates to the foretelling of the future.<sup>4</sup>
4. Ouija boards and their associated paraphernalia, especially when used as portals, or to contact the dead or other spirits.

This isn't to say there aren't any good drug therapies, (usually those that involve a cure, which is preferable to “treatment” over an indefinite period of time,) but much of the industry is now pervaded with sorcery. If someone asks you to take a pill for an uncertain or indefinite period of time, be wary. The elderly are particularly susceptible to being victimized by the pharmaceutical industry; if you doubt it, simply ask an elder to look in his/her medicine cabinet. Chances are you'll see rows of pill bottles.

Some psychotropic drugs, such as anti-depressants, can be of some help in some severe cases, but they should not be used for long periods of time, except in the most extreme of cases. They usually lose their effectiveness anyway over a long period of time, and all the while the brain chemistry is being altered, with often unknown long-term effects.

There is obviously a problem with our current system. One of the contributing factors (and this is a problem with our current capitalist system) is that the main objective of corporations is to earn a profit, and the biggest drug suppliers are currently corporations; therefore, it is in a corporation's interest to get people hooked on drugs and keep them reliant on them. Things might work better if our healing providers were non-profit organizations or at least organizations whose sole purpose is not to make money. And mandatory health insurance? Wouldn't that just result in the subsidization of an already corrupt system?

The current situation is bad enough... but the *next* biggest upcoming issue is that the government is *creating* disabled people who are perfectly capable of working, but who are not able to because the government has, in effect, blacklisted them by producing criminals out of them. In many cases drugs are used as a tool to do this; in this way, drugs are being used to fuel the modern slavery movement. As an example, there is a very good friend of mine who is in prison whose mandatory release date is set for 2017, (and as of 2010 she's already served 7 years,) mainly for being involved with drugs. (Getting other people hooked on drugs is not a good thing to do, but the sentence length does seem a bit excessive.) Murderers, rapists, child molesters, and thieves often don't get as much time as she got. She was doing technical support for the Colorado Department of Corrections, making \$3.50 a day. While this is significantly more money than prisoners were making a few years ago, it is still, in effect, slavery.

- The United States incarcerates more people for drug offenses than the European Union does for all offenses combined.
- The Colorado prison population has grown 604% since 1980, while the population of the state grew 59%.
- The Department of Corrections budget is \$703 million, up from \$70 million in 1985.
- The U.S. federal government spent over \$19 billion dollars in 2003 on the War on Drugs, at a rate of about \$600 per second. The budget has since been increased by over a billion dollars. State and local governments spent at least another \$30 billion.
- Someone is arrested every 20 seconds. Arrests for drug law violations [alone] in 2007 [were] expected to exceed the 1,678,192 [total] arrests of 2003.

You can see from these statistics that keeping drugs illegal is very profitable. Any reasonable thinking person should see that criminalizing drugs is about money, and not about the welfare of our society.

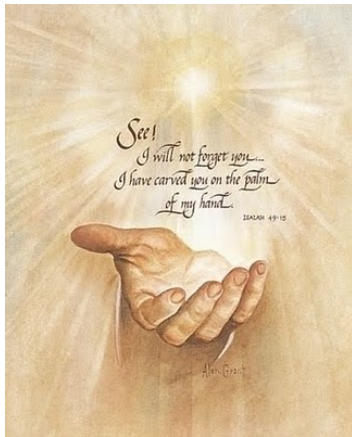

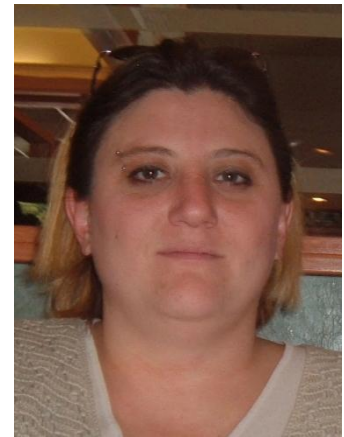

# THE MARK OF THE BEAST

*NOTE: The following is a somewhat subjective writing, while Section §3 on the next page was given by revelation.*

There are some interesting markings on the €20 (Euro) currency; this and other signs could lead one to the conclusion that either the beast is here, or it is soon to be. [This particular beast in the Book of Revelation is understood to be simply a system that man has created, inspired by the devil.] But let's consider the monetary system in the U.S.—money is made by new loans, and since there isn't enough money in circulation to cover the interest on the loans besides the loans themselves, foreclosures and repossessions are guaranteed to happen, no matter how well the economy is doing. Are you a slave to a bank?

Please note the attached picture. [Turns out it is the picture of a Catholic church. *Bless the Catholic workers, for many have brought life in times of strife. And, some ancient writings once locked away in the Vatican are becoming more accessible to the peoples of the world.*<sup>1</sup>] There are two sets of three clusters of six-winged circles on the face of the currency (remember that it is thought that the number of the beast is 666). Note also that Stars of David are six-pointed. These, however, are not Stars of David.

Note the Masonic influences (five-pointed stars, six-pointed Stars of David, etc.) in many currencies around the world. Apparently Freemasonry and "Christianity," or at least the teachings of Christ, conflict, as seen by the following snippet taken from the Freemason's Wasatch Lodge (Salt Lake City, Utah) website <http://www.wasatchlodge.org/index.php?p=4&msgcat=1>: "In addition to its role as a symbol of written wisdom and inspiration, the VSL [Volume of the Sacred Law or Lore] symbol is what Masonic obligations are sworn on." Many Masons use the Bible. Does swearing on a sacred book, wherein teachings of its principal progenitor command to "swear not at all," (see below,) amount to blasphemy? This practice in Freemasonry could stem from the times of the Old Testament, particularly that of the Temple of Solomon, where oaths and their execution were commonly practiced. Indeed, swearing was law for the Israelites: "Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and serve him, and shalt swear by his name." (Deuteronomy 6:13)

LDS temple rituals share some similarities with these Masonic oaths, although the LDS refer to theirs as performing covenants instead, and many LDS say that it makes sense that the Masonic

oaths are similar because the LDS versions are the true and restored versions of those rituals.

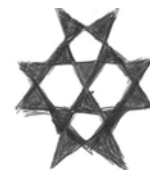
Matthew 5:33-37 and 3 Nephi 12:33-37 (Jesus makes it quite clear that oaths are no longer to be sworn):
