

# "What is the most pressing sociological issue facing disabled Americans today?"

The most pressing issue facing disabled Americans is that many are subjugated by the pharmaceutical companies, the medical community, and the government, who are involved in getting millions of Americans hooked on some type of drug or another, which provides a continual revenue stream for numerous agencies and corporations.

She is doing technical support for the Colorado Department of Corrections, making \$3.50 a day. While this is significantly more money than prisoners were making a few years ago, it is still, in effect, slavery.
